Driveway Policy for Town Roads Only

It is understood that the proper setting of driveway pipes and entrances to the town roadways are important, not only for drainage but safe placement of entrance to the highway.

As needed the Highway Department will install pipes and entrances as follows:

- 1- Maximum amount of pipe supplied by the Town is 40 ft. in length, when more is needed land owner will supply at their cost.
- 2- A maximum of two loads of crushed gravel will be supplied by the Town for each entrance, at a distance of no more than 30 ft. from edge of blacktop or edge of road if not blacktop. When entrance is deep off from roadway, bank run gravel or screenings will be used to bring to grade needed and top with 2-3 inches of crushed gravel to seal entrance to stop erosion and tracking of mud onto roadway.

It is the land owner's responsibility to maintain this entrance as part of their driveway from this day forward.

- 3- Maintenance to existing driveways will only be preformed when:
  - A- Reconstruction of roadways or raising of roadway.

Adjustment to taper in and pipe changes to meet existing driveways will accrue as needed.

- B- Blockages holding water against roads, increasing the chances of water causing damage to road or shoulder, will be for the Towns asset and taken care of as needed.

The Highway Superintendent will use his judgment in each instance.
