Local Law No. 1 of the year 2014

A local law to amend Local Law 1 of the year 2010 to increase penalties and to provide for the addition

Article 1-Increasement of Penalties:

Section of Local Law 1 of the year 2010, shall be amended as follow:

- (a) For a first violation, a fine of \$100.00.
- (b) For a second offense, within a one year period, a fine of no less than \$100.00, and nor more than \$150.00
- (c) For a third offense or subsequent offense within a one year period, a fine of no less than \$100.00 or more than \$200.00.

Article 2. Special Assessment.

Section 7 of the Local Law of the year 2010 shall be amended as follows:

A, If a penalty is not paid within ninety (90) days of its assessment, the presiding Town of Croghan Justice shall cause notice of said unpaid penalty to be sent to the owner of the parcel on which the subject dog was harbored at the time of the violation. Such notice shall advise the owner that the penalty will be added to the realty taxes for said parcel. Said notice shall advise the owner that if the fine remains unpaid by October 31 of the year, notice shall be sent to Lewis County Real Property Tax Services, and the amount of the unpaid penalty as well as a \$50.00 Administrative cost surcharge will be added to the tax rolls for the subject parcel.

B. On or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November each year, the Town of Croghan Town Clerk/Tax Collector, shall advise the Office of Lewis County Real Property Tax Services of unpaid penalties. The amount of said unpaid penalties, and an Administrative cost surcharge in the amount of \$50.00 for each unpaid penalty, shall be added to the realty taxes for the parcel on which the subject dog was harbored.
